**Emergency First Aid**

We are running sessions all week (Mon-Thurs 9am & 2.45pm) for you and your child to attend to find out how to respond to the following emergency incidents.

1. Choking
2. An unresponsive child who is breathing. (recovery position)
3. An unresponsive child who isn't breathing. (CPR)
